Activity	<p>"Picture It" Before reading a book, look at the pictures first and have child tell their own story using the pictures as a guide</p> <p>*Practice Potty-Training</p>	<p>"Listen for the Sound" Sit, listen, and identify sounds with child. Ask child if the sound is loud or soft.</p>	<p>"Name that Body Part" During bath time, play Simon Says to teach child names of body parts.</p> <p>*Practice Potty-Training</p>	<p>"I Spy" Using a paper towel roll as a telescope, pick out an object (I spy something blue) and have child identify object using telescope and ask questions about object</p>	<p>"Color Scavenger Hunt" Look for objects in home of different colors. Have a scavenger hunt asking child to find objects in the home of the different colors (Find me something yellow)</p> <p>*Practice Potty-Training</p>	<p>"Nature Walk" Take a walk outside and have child to identify different things that they see. Ask child questions according to answers given</p>	<p>"Freeze" Turn on music and have child to dance. When the music stops playing, the child must freeze until the music starts again</p> <p>*Practice Potty-Training</p>

Activity	<p>"Handwashing Song" Have child to practice proper handwashing while singing handwashing song</p>	<p>"My Favorite Food" Find pictures of different food and have child sort food according to what is healthy and unhealthy</p> <p>*Practice Potty-Training</p>	<p>"Sock Toss" Make balls out of socks and have child to toss socks in basket or bucket while helping them count as they toss</p>	<p>"Look at Me" Using a paper plate, have child draw a picture of themselves using crayons, markers, or other materials</p> <p>*Practice Potty-Training</p>	<p>"Marching Band" Show child how to march in a band by marching knees high beating on objects that make noise</p>	<p>"Let's Get Dressed" Practice with child putting on clothes (putting on shirt, pulling up pants, putting on socks)</p> <p>*Practice Potty-Training</p>	<p>"Airplane, Airplane" Pretend to be an airplane with arms stretched wide while showing kids how to lean to the left and right</p>
