Activity	During bottle feeding, hold your infant in your arms, hold your infant hand on the bottle and place your hand over the infants hand but release the infant hand at any signs of discomfort. Name eating utensils.	Place your infant on his/her back, talk to them describing in detail what you are doing and why. Once you have your infant on his or her back make funny faces at your infant.	Hold a rattle in front of an infant, shake it in a direction in which your infant is not looking. When your infant look in the direction of the rattle switch sides and repeat the activity.	Hold your infant in your lap, point to words as you read a book, mail, text message, recipe, can label, or any item you can find with written words.	Hold your infant by the wrist and say up as you pull them up to a standing position and down as you lower them down to a sitting position.	Place your infant on his/her back, talk to them describing in detail what you are doing and why. Once you have your infant on his or her back make funny faces at your infant.	As you are dressing your infant encourage them to help put their clothes on and discuss the clothing item and the part of the body each item goes on and why we need the clothing item.

During diapering make eye contact with your infant and discuss each step of diapering as you are changing your infant.	Place your infant on his or her stomach and place a toy in front of them and encourage them to reach for the toy.	Take your infant on a nature walk, talk about what they are interested in or looking at during the walk.	Sing Nursery Rhymes to your infant.	Encourage handwashing daily before and after meals, diapering, floor activities, outdoor activities	As you are taking your infant a bath, name the body parts you are washing. Tell the function of each body part
